Meet Data!



Data is the facts about you that we collect from your parents / carers / agent.

The facts that we know about you may include: your full name, your date of birth, your address, your email address, your telephone numbers, your test scores, your medical and dietary information and your education history.

We get those facts from your parents / carers / agent.

We keep your data for the time that you study with us. We also keep it after your studies have finished if you have told us that you want us to stay in touch with you.

We use your data as part of the agreement that we have with your parents / carers / agent for your education with us, both for online courses and for if you stay with us and take a course.

Data gives you rights. You have the right to ask us to correct any errors in your data. You have the right to move your data. You have the right to ask us to delete your data. If you want to explore these rights further, then tell your parents, carers or agent and they will let us know.
